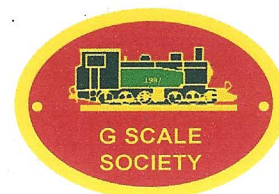


Annual General Meeting

Treasurer's Report

The Accounts had been circulated to members and Martin Cook reported that they had now been audited. The result shows a £38 surplus but no bill had yet been received for the hall at Pratts Bottom, which would mean a £60 deficit this year. Acceptance proposed by Alex Evans-Crane and seconded by Andy Parkins and agreed.

Election of the Committee

The current committee were prepared to continue and there had been no new nominations. It was proposed by John Bentley and seconded by Alex Evans-Crane and agreed by the meeting that the committee be re-elected.

Garden Meets

Roger Allen stated that attendance at Pratts Bottom and a couple of the garden Meets had been disappointing and that the Committee were keen to organise events that met the needs of the members. Any other offers would be welcome and as soon as dates were fixed a list would be posted on the web site. It was agreed that Kent is a big County and the issue of travel distance may put some off attending and that September should be avoided as the schools had just gone back. Teynham remained our big Event and perhaps Canterbury or Ashford might be worth exploring. The Higham meet with the 16mm group had attracted a few as a Running Day, not open to the public and might be repeated.

Any other business

Adam Adlam in sending his apologies, thanked the Committee for all their work on behalf of the members. Alex Evans-Crane suggested that we should use Youtube to upload videos of events to publicise our activities. The National event was discussed but the distance was seen as an issue. It was suggested that perhaps a mini-bus or car share scheme could be organised for events such as the Surrey or Sussex events.
